- 1. All of the forms are saved on google docs using the following links. Please open them and make a copy so that you can edit these forms.
 - a. The forms should be returned via email to Mike Raso at the end of the work.
- 2. The <u>Curriculum Writing Template</u> is a form used to guide your work. It is based on Backwards Design by Wiggins and McTighe and adjusted to fit our PLC process.
 - a. The document is intended to be a guide for UNIT design. Several of these documents could be used to describe an entire course.
 - b. The document is intended to guide your work. It does not need to be finished to completion in the summer but should continue to guide your work throughout the year. Return what you have at the end of the summer so you can get paid.
 - c. One unit needs to be turned in for the entire group.

- 4. The <u>Curriculum Writing Procedure Form</u> needs to be turned in and signed by each person.
