| Confidentiality | Do not discuss children, grades, teachers, or problems outside of the classroom or offices. No child or staff member is to be the subject of negative, degrading, or uncomplimentary information disseminated outside the school environment. If you see a problem, consult the building administrator or the Volunteer Program Director. |
| Communication | The total experience of volunteering is to support teachers and students. It should be a rewarding and learning experience for everyone involved. Please be open and approach the appropriate school personnel with questions, concerns or interpretations of policies or procedures. |
